Leaves	This simple, charming story of a young bear's first autumn is perfectly suited to board book format. Bear is surprised when the leaves start falling off the trees, but when he tries to reattach them, it doesn't work.	Ages Birth+
Fall Leaves	Part poem, part silent stage with luminous light-box illustrations, this innovative picture book puts autumn on display to capture the art and science of season change.	Ages 4 yrs+
Let's Look at Fall	How do we know it's fall? The weather is cooler, and the leaves change color. Crops are ready for harvest, and animals get ready for winter. This book shows young readers how to recognize the changes that happen in fall.	Ages 4 yrs+
Apple Picking Time	In the rich, warm colors of autumn, here's a slice of American history as we watch Anna and her extended family help with the town's traditional fall apple harvest.	Ages 3 yrs+
Apple Farmer Annie	Filled with bright primary colors and pictures of America's favorite fruit, Wellington's enticing story follows Annie, a busy apple farmer. She picks, counts, sorts, bakes tasty treats, and sells her best apples.	Ages 3-5 yrs
Leaf Man	Fall has come, the wind is gusting, and Leaf Man is on the move. Is he drifting east, over the marsh and ducks and geese? Or is he heading west, above the orchards, prairie meadows, and spotted cows? No one's quite sure, but this much is certain: A Leaf Man's got to go where the wind blows.	Ages 4 yrs+
Awesome Autumn	Autumn is awesome! Leaves change color. Animals fly south or get ready to hibernate. People harvest crops and dress up as scary creatures for Halloween. And then there are pickup football games to play, Thanksgiving foods to eat, leaf piles to jump in—all the amazing things that happen as the air turns crisp and cool.	Ages 4 yrs+
Pumpkin Pumpkin	Jamie plants a pumpkin seed in the spring and, after watching it grow all summer, carves a face in it for Halloween! But best of all, he saves some seeds that he will plant again next spring.	Ages 4 yrs+
I See Fall	Experience the many joys of fall—from pumpkins and leaves to apples and Halloween!	Ages 2 yrs+
Pumpkin Soup	Cat, Squirrel, and Duck make their pumpkin soup the same way every day, until Duck wants to switch jobs, and eventually storms off, leaving his friends to worry and, finally, search for him.	Ages 4 yrs+
The Biggest Pumpkin Ever	Two lovable mice take such good care of their growing pumpkin that it becomes the biggest pumpkin ever!	Ages 4 yrs+
Sophie's Squash	On a trip to the farmers' market with her parents, Sophie chooses a squash, but instead of letting her mom cook it, she names it Bernice. From then on, Sophie brings Bernice everywhere, despite her parents' gentle warnings that Bernice will begin to rot. As winter nears, Sophie does start to notice changes.... What's a girl to do when the squash she loves is in trouble?	Ages 3 yrs+
The Bus for Us	In The Bus for Us book, follow Tess on her first day of school and her very first ride on a school bus. Waiting at the bus stop with her older friend Gus, Tess eagerly asks, "Is this the bus for us, Gus?" as each vehicle passes by.	Ages 5 yrs+
The Season's of Arnold's Apple Tree	The Seasons of Arnold's Apple Tree Book presents an apple tree's changes through all four seasons, as witnessed by the child who loves it.	Ages 4 yrs+
Tap the Magic Tree	One brown tree stands lonely and bare. But when readers open this book, they bring magic with them. Tap the tree once, turn the page, and a bright green leaf has sprouted! Tap again—one, two, three, four—and four more leaves have grown on the next page. Pat, clap, wiggle, jiggle, and see blossoms bloom, apples grow, and the leaves swirl away with the autumn breeze. Feast for 10	A counting book that features an African-American family shopping for food, preparing dinner, and sitting down to eat. Lively read-aloud text.	Ages 2 yrs+
The Thankful Book	Todd Parr's Thankful Book celebrates all the little things children can give thanks for. From everyday activities like reading and bathtime to big family meals together and special alone time between parent and child, Todd inspires readers to remember all of life's special moments.	Ages 3 yrs+
Thank You, Omu	Everyone in the neighborhood dreams of a taste of Omu's delicious stew! One by one, they follow their noses toward the scrumptious scent.
